

Take part in “Cruise Day” at Hoverally ’23!

– Friday, July 14 –

All attendees are welcome to join. The schedule of events was purposefully designed so that racers could join the cruisers in the fun of journeying up the Mississippi and St. Croix Rivers. If you don't have a craft, ask around for a ride. There always seems to be someone with seats available.

We will be meeting at the registration booth next to Paradise Cove (see Event Map) at **12:00 p.m. (Noon)** for a brief captains meeting before the group sets out. A group leader and group follower will be designated at this meeting. The leader and the follower are there to make sure everyone knows where they are going and that nobody gets lost along the way. We will then proceed through Sturgeon Lake and head up the Mississippi River to the confluence of the St. Croix River at Prescott, WI. Luckily, there will be no locks and dams that we will encounter on the cruise this year.

FIRST STOP: We will be stopping at Prescott Island, which is approximately 11 miles from the Treasure Island Marina. The group leader will stop on a sandbar and wait for everyone to catch up in order to make sure everyone's craft is operating smoothly. After the brief stop, the group will head north up the St. Croix River.



DESTINATION: The group is headed towards Hudson Pier Beach approximately 17 miles from the First Stop in Prescott, WI (28 miles from Treasure Island Marina). This is a popular place where people park their boats and sit on the beach. The Hudson Pier extends to the beach, connecting it with Hudson's traditional downtown. There are many restaurants and bars to choose from, for those that want to venture into town.
